Principal's Report: Dr. Hancock

- Projectors for classroom: Dr. Hancock updated PTO members on the in-ceiling projectors for the classrooms. 6 teachers have requested projectors. The current budget included funds for 5 projectors (3 from PTO, 2 from school budget). Dr Hancock held a lottery to determine who would receive the projectors. Considering the fact that \$10,000 was allocated from the PTO budget for this expense, and 3 projectors cost only \$8,655, PTO members agreed to spend the remaining funds allocated toward this project and split the cost of a 6th projector with Dr. Hancock's remaining school budget. Consequently, all 6 teachers who requested in-ceiling projectors will receive them for their classroom. Costs have been minimized by utilizing current projectors to install via ceiling mount.
- Book exchange has been named the "Nitrauer Book Nook" and will take place in the computer lab on one date in March, April, and May. The first date is March 7. Parent helpers are needed to assist in transitioning students from the classroom to the Book Nook. The cost of books is \$0.25 for paperback and \$0.50 for hard cover. During the first sale kids will only be able to purchase 1 book. Laura is attempting to get a donation of an organizational system from a local store. Books will be sorted and displayed by grade level. There is a need for upper level chapter books.
- NItrauer school wide "Bucket-filling" was switched in February to "Random Acts
 of Kindness." Students that are nominated for showing random acts of kindness
 will receive hearts that are hanging in the hallway.
