2. Presented an "Early Learning Initiative" slideshow, highlighting the District's mission: District Comprehensive Plan - from Pre-K to Graduation. In 2018-2019, Manheim Township has experienced a 1.2% growth followed behind by CV (0.7%). We are currently the top enrolling school district in Lancaster County. This new initiative for all kindergarten enrollees will begin at Neff-6 in 2022. All kindergarteners would attend school at Neff and no longer be enrolled in our District's elementary schools. We own Neff-6 building and rent it out to the IU-13.
