President: Maggie Foley - Opened meeting

Treasurer: Christina Lott - Provided updated copies of Treasurer's report, showing YTD (year to date) income and expenses.

Principal: Dr. Wendy Hancock - requests new auditorium projector to PTO (in the future); 1st grade classes are visiting the HS Planetarium; discussed all upcoming Spanish Immersion classes will move this fall 2020-2021 to Reidenbaugh Elementary from Nitrauer Elementary - all the same Spanish teachers will move as a unit - any parents who were unable to attend the meeting, were personally called; Dr. Barlet heads up the Spanish Immersion - incoming immersion students will have a parent meeting in March at Reidenbaugh Elementary

SLAC Representative Report - Jenine Nicholas: Updated PTO on lengthy public meeting/presentation by Dr. Felty - stated last year's 5th and 7th graders were not performing up to standards (PVAS - shows growth of proficiency band and measures/predicts upward achievement or not); briefly discussed high school students in P.E. class - each graded differently/not uniformly; lease with IU-13 will not be renewed -- therefore, early learning center will not occur next year (would be dedicated to kindergarten classes) - now pending future date; enrollment from surrounding new developments has increased - will increase number of total student body; relayed the board does not want to do redistricting, at this time; most of presentation was focused/related to intermediate to high-school age

Nitrauer Play "Peter Pan" - Diana Hanna: play is underway with practices; play to be performed in April 2020

Book Fair - Mr. Murphy (Teacher Rep): Gave thanks to the PTO and student families for attending Bingo night and for participating in the school's book fair
